God is Faithful!

Take Home Point:

You can count on God!

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY

- We praised God with singing and dancing.
- Faithfulness, The Mango Giraffe joined us and we learned that we can count on God! He is Faithful.
- We talked about and saw pictures from Rays of Peace Orphanages.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from Children's Bible or Bible verses:

Lord, your love is as high as the heavens. Your faithful love reaches to the skies. Psalm 36:5

But the fruit of the Holy Spirit produces love, joy, and peace. It is being patient, kind and good. It is being faithful and gentle and having control of oneself. Galatians 5:22-23a

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Where can we find the promises of God? *(We can find them in His book, the Bible. If he promised it in the Bible, it is still for me today!)*
- Does God keep his promises? *(Yes He does!)*
- What are some of those promises? *(God promises that He will always hear us, nothing can separate us from His Love, He will take care of us, He will save and rescue us, those who believe in him will one day live with Him forever in heaven...)*

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)

Dear God,
You are faithful to us. You always keep your promises, and you will never forget. Help us to trust you and believe your promises. We love you. Thank you for loving us.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Read through **Psalm 136** and have your children say "God's love goes on forever," every time you pause at the end of each verse. Then have them list ways God shows your family that His love goes on forever. After listing ways that God is faithful, read through your list, creating your own Psalm of praise by having your children say, "God's love goes on forever," each time you pause. Pray together, thanking God for His faithfulness. You may even choose to put your Psalm to music. Then, you can really sing a psalm, praising God for His faithfulness (**Colossians 3:16**).
